Supervision and Monitoring Process: Doctor of Management

 OYAGSB Doctor of Management (DMAN) is a practice-oriented doctoral research programme designed specially to meet the needs of the business sectors.

Requirement

- Research that solves industry problem.
- Identify problem based on industry focus and industry relevant.
- Must work with the industry partner and try to solve the problem that the industry is facing (Applied Research)
- Required to do Action Research.
- Appropriate for industry development.

Supervisor Responsibility

- Supervisor has the responsibility to ensure that the research is designed correctly.
- Supervisor has the responsibility to make sure that the research meets the requirement of an Action Research
- Supervisor has the responsibility to ensure that the student research is applied oriented or/ and demonstrable impact (improvement or changes).
- Supervisor has the responsibility to help student position his or her research in comparison to other current work and help them shape the project to fill in what is missing.
- Supervisor has the responsibility to assist student in his or her research design, execution and analysis of research activities in collaboration with the industry
- Supervisor needs to be up-to-date with the field

Supervision Process

Identify Problem

 Students should identify problem based on discussing with experts from different industry or industry of student focus.

Literature

• Do systematic literature review to find what has been done in academic to solve the problem (theoretical).

Methodology

- Device a hybrid solution.
- Co-creating theory and practice.
- Solve practical (business) problems by engaging in cocreation with practitioners and researcher to deepen understanding of ways to encounter practical problems in innovative ways. Thus, opens an avenue for the development of theory.

Contribution

 It needs to be novel and contribute to the industry (industry relevant)

Monitoring Process

- Engagement in practice-oriented process of doing research. It might be directly in meetings or joint events with the company, or indirectly by advising the doctorate on his or her interactions with practice.
- Monitoring administrative activities i.e., reporting of student progress.
